Description

This position will assist Accounting team in performing full-cycle support for the business written on other client's behalf including but not limited to daily accounts and cash processing, quarterly closing, sub-ledger reconciliations, and preparation of the financial statements. This position will require active communication with underwriters, claims, auditors to ensure the fulfillment of all terms of reinsurance agreements:

- Oversee daily FAC settlements and issue monthly FAC analysis; assist in Global A/R reconciliation, help with transition to a new General Ledger;
- Serve as liaison between Accounting, Collection, Claims and Underwriting for mismatch resolution; perform QC for parallel contracts to review estimated premium income, fees, Canadian portion, multiple sections, specifics of foreign markets, est.;
