NORTHWEST PACIFIC


- La Niña shifts the tropical cyclones to form closer to The Philippines and South China Sea
- Landfall probability increases for Southern China, The Philippines and Vietnam during Sept/Oct
- If tropical cyclones recurve they may make landfall in South Korea, southwest Japan (e.g. Kyushu) and southern Japan Islands (during peak months Aug/Sep)
- Neutral/La Niña slightly decreases landfall rate in Japan

EAST PACIFIC

- Expect near-average number of storms
- More active season (compared to 2020) for Mexico's West Coast during Sept/Oct

CENTRAL PACIFIC

 Expect below-average season due to colder water around the Hawaiian Islands (east/south)
