
ANTICIPATE A WILDFIRE SEASON SIMILAR TO 2018

Lower than average Winter/Spring precipitation (2018)

Higher than average Winter/Spring temperatures

Expect a warmer and drier Summer than average

Exacerbates current Western State drought conditions



HIGHER RISK AREAS INCLUDE

- California: Central Valley, East Bay, San Joaquin Valley, Coat Ranges, Sierra, and SoCal (toward the end of the season)
- Oregon: Central
- Washington: Southeast

High chance dry season extends into Fall and overlaps with Santa Ana & Diablo wind seasons.
