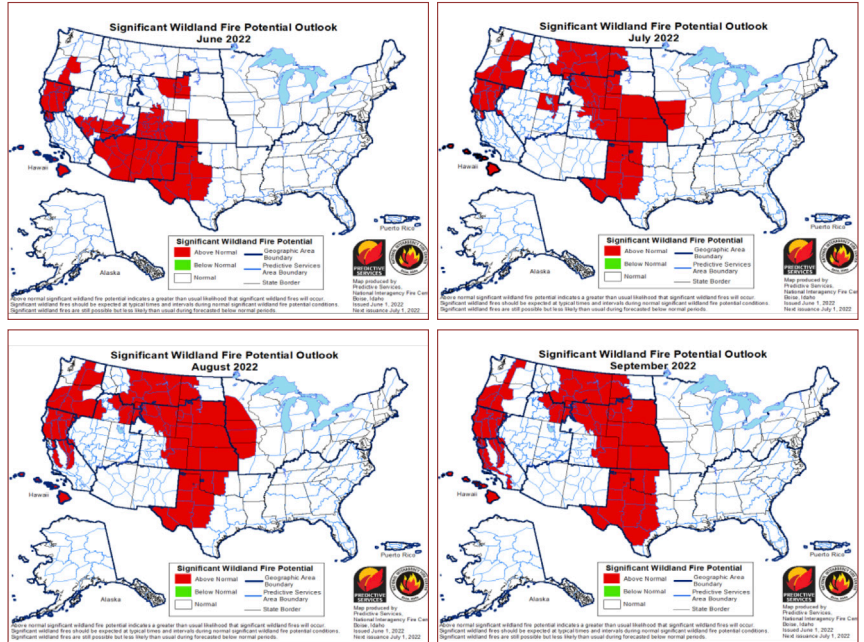
UNITED STATES

MOST OF THE WEST, PLAINS, AND TEXAS REMAIN IN A DROUGHT

- Summer precipitation is projected to be **below normal** across the Plains, the Central Rockies, and the Northwest. Expect **above normal** temperatures across most of the contiguous U.S.

SIGNIFICANT FIRE POTENTIALS AND ABOVE NORMAL CONDITIONS (JUNE THROUGH SEPTEMBER)

- **June:** Most of the Southwest, southern Great Basin, and southern Colorado
- **June-September:** Across Northern California and Oregon (central and western)
- **June-August:** Across most of the Northwest
- **August-September:** The Southern Sierra and Coast Ranges of SoCal

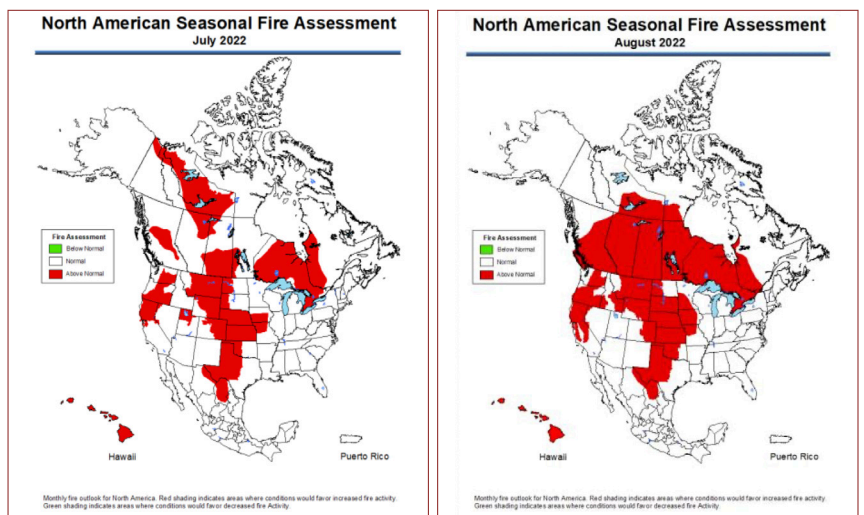


Fire season progression across the contiguous U.S. (June-August) ([Predictive Services](#))

ABOVE NORMAL CONDITIONS FORECASTED FOR JULY AND AUGUST

- Eastern Manitoba through Ontario and into western Quebec (July)
- British Columbia (central and southern) and eastward into western Quebec (August)
