The Internship Program

- The program will be 10 weeks and will run from early June through early August
- Weekly work schedule will be 35 hours and follow a hybrid schedule, approximately 2-3 days in-office with the remainder remote. All interns will be in-office on Tuesdays and Wednesdays
- Internship will be paid in connection with the academic college year you will be entering in Fall 2023:
 - Freshman & Sophomores: \$23 / hour
 - Juniors & Seniors: \$25 / hour
- During the program, the intern group will attend a series of educational sessions to provide them with perspectives on our company and the broader reinsurance industry
- Training and social activities will be structured into the program, allowing for networking opportunities with peers and colleagues

Description

Models for hurricane, earthquake, and other natural perils have become essential and ubiquitous tools in (re)insurance underwriting and risk management. Recent large loss events such as Hurricane Ian offer a unique opportunity to assess model performance and recalibrate assumptions. This role will allow you to gain exposure within Catastrophe Risk by analyzing recent catastrophic events. The summer-long project will include:

- Working with teams in modeling, claims and underwriting to compare modeled losses to actual losses for recent catastrophes
- Learning how to address important and impactful business questions utilizing model analysis
- Answering questions such as
 - Are there systematic sources of model bias?
 - Do certain clients or types of risks perform differently than expected?
 - Does data quality impact the accuracy of results?
- Presenting your findings to the Risk team, which will form an important part of TransRe's ongoing model research initiatives

Requirements

- Intermediate Microsoft Excel skills including performing calculations on large data sets, creating graphs and tables, inputting data, sorting data, and utilizing basic formulas
- Availability to participate in the entirety of the 10-week program
- Ability to work in-person at our offices located at 165 Broadway, New York, NY 10006
