

# North Atlantic Hurricane Outlook (April 2023)



Anticipate slightly below-average hurricane season

Neutral ENSO will transition to El Niño by summer (peak of the season)

Expect warmer than average Atlantic Sea Surface Temperature (SST)

## EL NIÑO CONDITIONS TO SUPPRESS ATLANTIC HURRICANE ACTIVITY BUT WARMER THAN AVERAGE SST MAY LEAD TO NEAR-AVERAGE SEASON
