



US Winter Outlook (2023-2024)

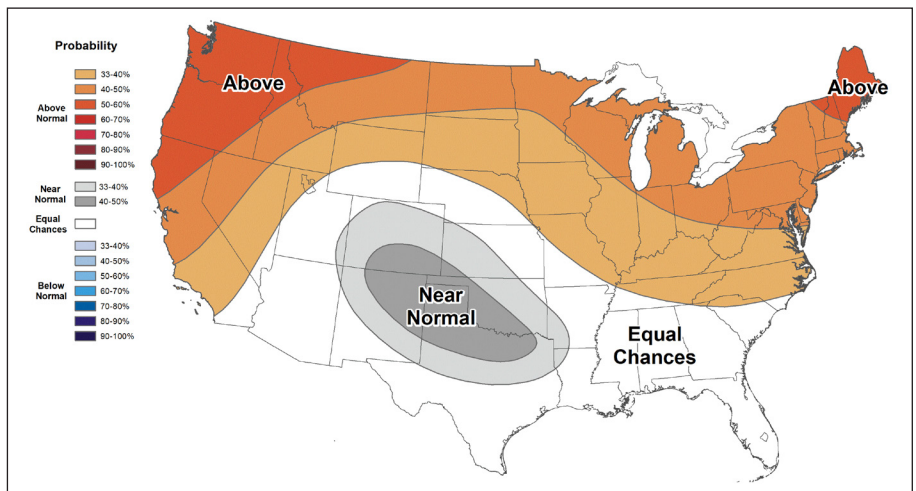
A WINTER EL NIÑO IS ANTICIPATED FOR THE FIRST TIME IN FOUR YEARS.

Strong El Niño conditions typically coincide with wetter and cooler weather conditions across the southern US, including active southwest atmospheric rivers, increased storm activity in the Southeast and a snowier Northeast. Drier and warmer weather typically continues across the northern US.

TEMPERATURE

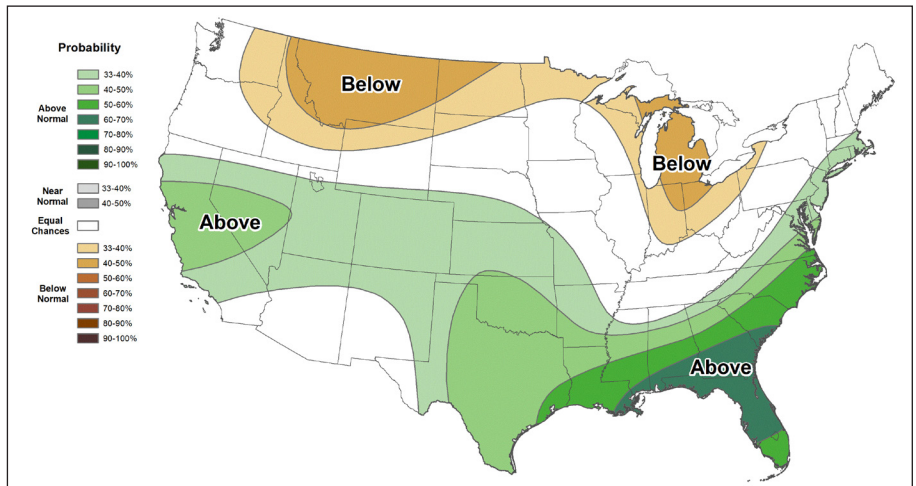
- Expect **warmer-than-average** temperatures in northern states, especially states at higher latitudes.
- Near-normal temperatures are **likely** to occur in the Plains.

PRECIPITATION

- Wetter-than-average conditions are **avored** for southern states from California through the Northeast.
- Expect **drier- than-average** conditions in the northern Rockies and Great Lakes region.
